

New at Vienna Airport: Increased frequencies and enhanced services from Vienna

In addition to the new services previously announced for summer season 2015, several airlines are increasing capacities from Vienna. Austrian Airlines, British Airways, China Airlines, Korean Air, Kuwait Airways, Qatar Airways and Turkish Airlines are either increasing frequencies or deploying larger aircraft.

As of beginning of June 2015, several airlines are expanding their flight service to Asia. China Airlines is increasing seat capacity to three weekly flights to Taipei, and is deploying a Boeing 747 instead of the previously used Airbus A340 aircraft. Korean Air is expanding frequencies to Seoul as of June 1, 2015 to four weekly flights with an additional Boeing 777. As of the beginning of July, it is also adding a fifth flight, operating another Boeing 777.

Qatar Airways is raising the number of weekly flights to Doha to nine during the period from July 1 till August 31, 2015, deploying a Boeing 787. Kuwait Airways will operate an Airbus 320 three times a week on its route from Vienna to Kuwait City from July 21 - October 24, 2015.

Austrian Airlines has announced plans to increase flights to Linz from six to ten weekly connections as of the beginning of June 2015. Turkish Airlines is increasing frequencies to Istanbul-Atatürk by two to 30 weekly flights in the period June 22 - September 19, 2015. As of September 17, 2015, British Airways is adding a new route to its network, and will operate Vienna to London-Gatwick up to six flights per week to.
